Ministerial Sponsorship Plan NADWP L 28

- Provides financial assistance to sponsoring conferences or church institutions for Master of Divinity students
- Master of Divinity students must be enrolled full time at the Andrews University Theological Seminary
- Completed a Bachelors degree with a major in Bible or religion
- Application approved by
 - Conference
 - Union
 - Andrews University Theological Seminary
 - NADCOA
- Not available for those with services in other lines of denominational work
- Under 30 years old with a possible exception of up to 35 years old

- 36-month plan
- Division portion paid quarterly to the Union

Financial Assistance to Self-Sponsored Masters of Divinity Graduates NADWP L 30

- Provides financial assistance to an unsponsored graduate from the Andrews University Theological Seminary
- Has not been previously employed in full-time pastoral ministry
- Application must be submitted within 3 years of the applicant's graduation date
- Applicant is employed in regular full-time pastoral ministry
- Application approved by
 - Conference
 - Union
 - Andrews University Theological Seminary
 - NADCOA
- Does not apply to interns paid on a part-time basis



Financial Assistance to Self-Sponsored Masters of Divinity Graduates Funding NADWP L 30

- 12-month plan

- Renewable for a second year with continued training assignments to provide as wide and varied experience as possible
- May be considered for regular appointment as opening become available during the second year
- Application approved by

 - Recommendation by college/university faculty

- Or the completion of an approved computer certification such as Novell and/or Microsoft
- Intern shall be appointed for 12 months with approval of union committee and with training and supervision provided by employing organization
- Renewable for a second year with continued training assignments to provide as wide and varied experience as possible
- May be considered for regular appointment as opening become available during the second year
- Application approved by
 - Conference
 - Union
 - Recommendation by college/university faculty
 - NADCOA

- Renewable for a second year with continued training assignments to provide as wide and varied experience as possible
- May be considered for regular appointment as opening become available during the second year
- Application approved by
 - Conference
 - Union
 - Recommendation by college/university faculty
 - NADCOA

Internships: Communication NADWP FC 37

- For recent graduates in Communication or a communication-related field from SDA colleges/universities
- Employer submits request to NAD Communications Department with
 - Job description
 - Remuneration information
 - Applicant's resume
- Intern shall consist of two years of full-time communication-related work under the supervision of a qualified communication person
- Employing organization to submit reports after 6 months, after 12 months, and at the end of the internship
- Application approved by
 - Conference
 - Union
 - NAD Communication Department
 - NADCOA

- Two-year plan
- Division portion paid quarterly to the Union
- Application available upon request for the North American Division Communication Department

Women in Pastoral Ministry NAD Secretariat

- Available for female applicants who have never been employed by the church as a pastor
- Preferred degree is an MDiv from Andrews University Theological Seminary
- Conference must be willing to make a long-term commitment to the female pastor beyond the financial assistance
- Funding from the conference, union, and division is for three consecutive years
- Funding is based on the NAD remuneration factor
- · Limit of 20 individuals sponsored throughout the division per year
- Application approved by
 - Conference
 - Union
 - Division

Regional Scholarship and Capital Reversion Fund NADWP S 82

- Funding NAD allocates 6% of tithe remitted to the NAD by the Regional Conferences/Churches (NPUC & PUC)
- NADWP S 82 10 Regional Capital Reversion Fund 75%
 - Funds distributed on a rotating basis with a minimum of two conferences and a maximum of four conferences benefiting each year
 - Current rotation is three conferences each year
 - Eligible projects
 - Boarding/day academies
 - Conference office buildings
 - Up to 50% of the cost of a specific campground project
 - Major church buildings
 - Adventist Book Centers



Regional Scholarship and Capital Reversion Fund NADWP S 82

- NADWP S 82 15 Regional Scholarship Fund 25%
 - Graduate education, primarily medical, dental, and business professions and other professions the church has the greatest need for leadership (listed on application)
 - Must be
 - Member of a Regional Conference/Office of Regional Affairs in NPUC or PUC
 - Citizen of the USA
 - Full-time student.
 - · Able to submit verification of financial need
 - Application must be submitted to Conference/Union by December 1, to the NAD Office by January 31, and to NAD Treasury by March 31
 - Amount varies by degree
 - May apply for multiple years based on degree
 - Approved by NADCOA
 - Application available on the NAD Treasury webpage (https://www.nadadventist.org/departments/treasury)



Hispanic Church Building and Scholarship Fund NADWP S 84

- Funding NAD allocates 6% of tithe retained by the NAD from Hispanic churches excluding Hispanic churches in Regional Conferences
- The union shall allocate an amount equivalent to 10% of the union portion of tithe from Hispanic churches excluding Hispanic churches in Regional Conferences
- NADWP S 84 05 3. Hispanic Church Building 85%
 - Funds distributed to each union based on tithe and membership



Hispanic Church Building and Scholarship Fund NADWP S 84

- NADWP S 84 05 4. Hispanic Scholarship Fund 15%
 - Must be
 - A Seventh-day Adventist
 - A NAD-based Hispanic
 - Full-time student
 - Able to submit verification of financial need
 - A student who is a member of a Hispanic church that belongs to a Regional Conference needs to apply to the Regional Scholarship
 - Granted based on need for approved courses of study
 - May apply multiple years
 - Approved by NADCOA
 - Application available on the Multilingual Ministries webpage (https://www.nadadventist.org/departments/multilingual-ministries)



Women's Ministries Scholarship Program

- Established to give scholarships to women who are committed to serving the mission of the Seventh-day Adventist Church who would otherwise be unable to afford a Christian education.
- Awarded based on academic achievement, financial need, and community outreach
- Amount varies based on the amount of funds available (funding from the sale of the Women's Ministries Devotional Book)
- Any woman who is enrolled in a SDA college/university in the NAD
- Undergraduate students only, priority given to those in their last two years
- Applicants must have a current GPA of at least 3.0
- October 15 application deadline

NADEIF Funds

- Funding \$500,000 from the \$10 millions Special Assistance fund
- Conference/Union may apply for funding for specific projects
- Application available on the Multilingual Ministries webpage (https://www.nadadventist.org/departments/multilingual-ministries)



Adventist Community Services Grants Program

- ACS Seed Grant Covers 75% (up to \$10,000) of a capital improvement costs for new or existing ACS centers
- Disaster Response Grant Funds ACS Disaster Response activities after a state or presidentially declared disaster
 - Only available for conferences or unions
 - One grant per event
 - Must be received an approved by NAD ACS DR prior to implementation
 - Not eligible: payments to disaster response organizations, payments to disaster survivors, repair of church-owned properties or payments to volunteer services
- ACS DR Mobile Unit Grant Covers up to 50% of the purchase and preparation of trailers or vehicles used for disaster response

Direct Tithe Given to the NAD

- Returned in December to three Unions on a rotating basis
- Union then distributes to Conferences
- May not go to a Mission



Plant 1000 Church Plant Funding

- \$10,000 for new church plants
- Three every year from conferences with less than 15,000 members
- Four every year for conferences with more than 15,000 members
- Funding from the GC, the NAD, Unions, Conferences and donors

Urban Centers of Influence (UCI)

- Global Mission will provide up to 50 percent of the total cost of a UCI
- The division, union, and conference/mission together are required to contribute at least 30 percent of the total cost of the project

Mission Impact Fund

- GC Planned Giving and Trust Services
- In the final development stage
- For all types of local church projects such as evangelism, healthy lifestyle classes, building projects, etc
- Funding from 20% of unrestricted maturities of planned gifts or specific donations divided among the 13 Divisions
- Applications will be available at <u>willplan.org/missionimpactfund</u>
- Proposals must be submitted to GC PGTS by May 1
- Funding decisions announced at Annual Council
