






International Standards on Auditing (ISA) are professional **standards** for the performance of financial **audit** of financial information. These **standards** are issued by **International** Federation of Accountants (IFAC) through the **International Auditing** and Assurance **Standards** Board (IAASB).



Since IT is such a integral part of everything today, in 2007 the international standard to certify accountants was changed to include some basic IT skills and knowledge an CPA/CA must have



This year the new ISA will be issued. As part of this standard, Audit of the Controls and Security of the IT environment supporting the accounting system and the company as a whole will be an integral part of the audit praxis and reports. We, the church/GCAS soon will have to follow that.

















Explain What is VDI?




















Adventist Cloud












First node up and running. Second Node being tested
