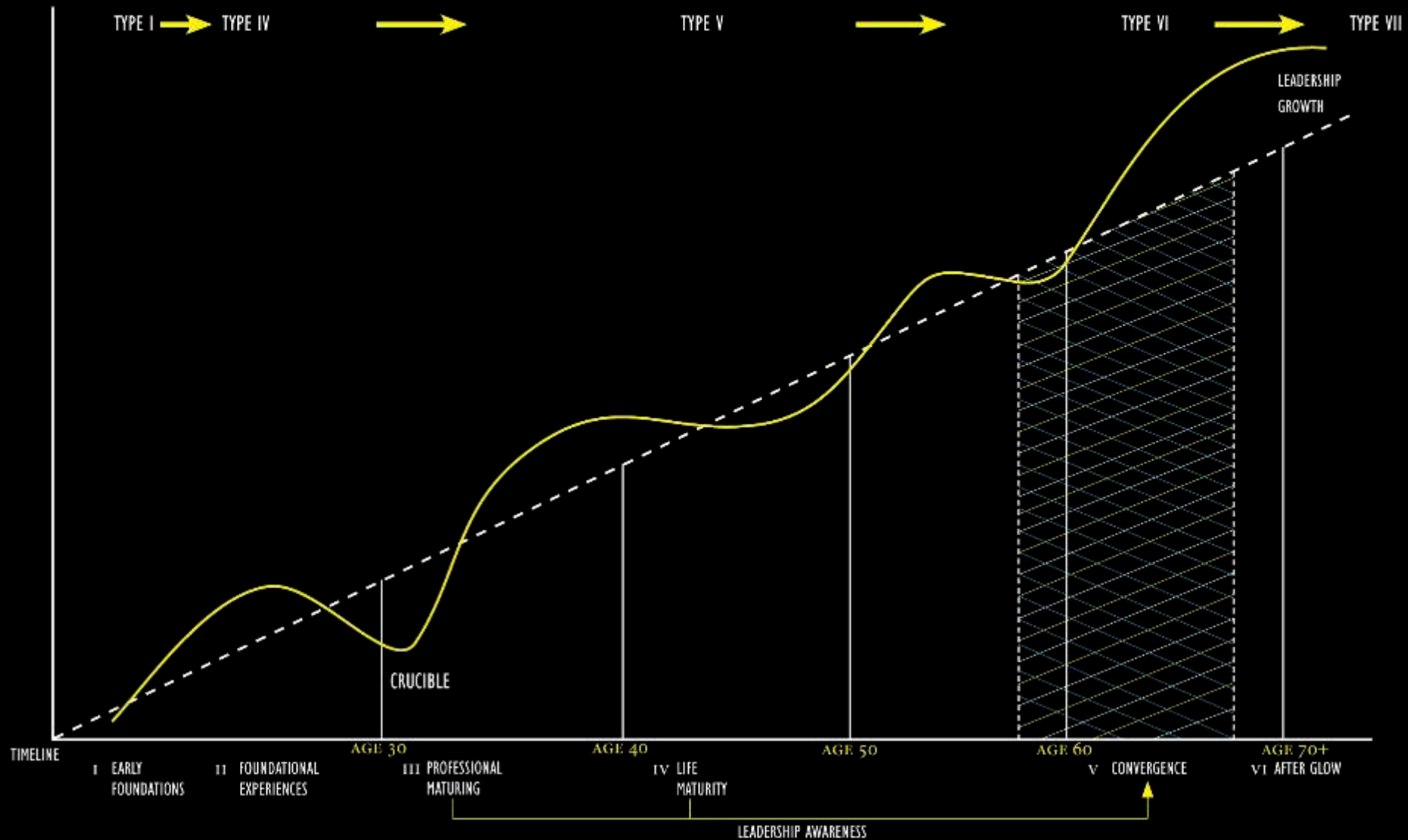
TIMELINE OF JUAN R. PRESTOL-PUESAN
